

## M&G (IRELAND) ETF ICAV

### GLOBAL SUPPLEMENT

M&G (Ireland) ETF ICAV (the “**ICAV**”), is an Irish Collective Asset-management Vehicle constituted as an umbrella fund with segregated liability between sub-funds authorised by the Central Bank of Ireland under registration number C557766 and pursuant to the UCITS Regulations.
